AFTER YOUR COLPOSCOPY

ACTIVITY:

You may resume your normal activity.

HYGIENE:

You may shower.

Do not place anything in the vagina i.e.: tampons or douches.

If a biopsy has been taken you should wait for 2 weeks before having vaginal intercourse. Intercourse could make the cervix bleed.

CARE:

If a biopsy was taken, you may have some vaginal bleeding and mild cramping for a few days.

CALL YOUR DOCTOR OR GO TO THE NEAREST EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT IF:

- You have vaginal bleeding (heavier than spotting) and you are not having your period.
- Severe abdominal pain.
- You have a fever greater than 38 degree C
- You have foul smelling vaginal discharge.

FOLLOW-UP:

Make an appointment to see the Surgeon 2 weeks after the procedure in the office for your results.
